The Arc of Calhoun and Cleburne Counties is a non-profit, United Way Agency which serves children and adults with intellectual and/or other developmental disabilities in Calhoun and Cleburne Counties, usually, free of charge.

## Who is eligible for your services?

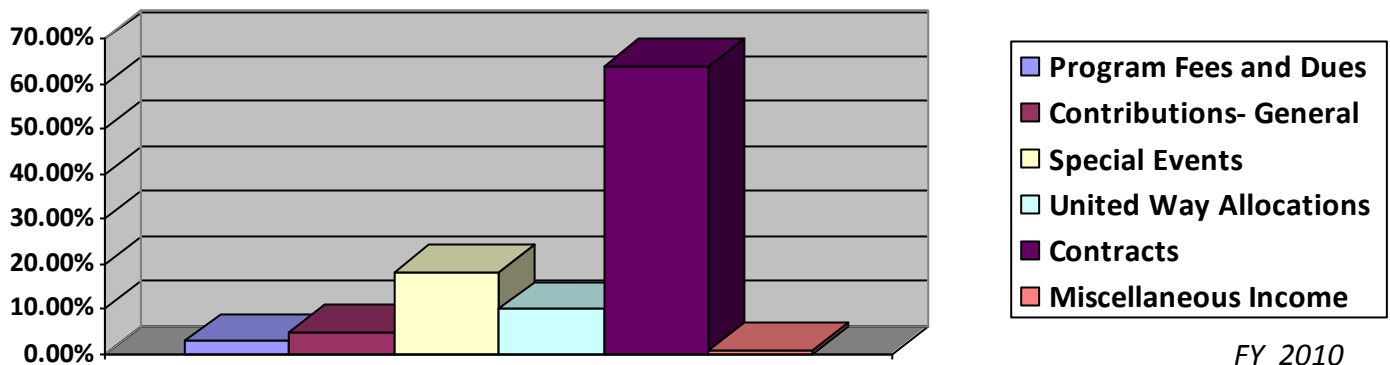
A person who has been determined through professional evaluation to have a “developmental disability” - a diverse group of chronic, severe disabilities resulting from mental and/or physical impairments. In most cases, a person with a developmental disability has been determined to be

- Five (5) years of age or older
- Have a disability which manifested itself before the age of 22 and continues throughout the person’s life-time
- Have difficulty in major life activities such as language, mobility, learning, self-help and independent living.

## What kind of services do you provide?

- Family Advocacy— home instruction, supported employment, and community support systems
- Recreational and social programs such as Special Olympics sports, art instruction, summer day camps and weekly and quarterly social activities for adults
- Education and prevention programs for the general population such as The Kids on the Block!
- Community and emergency assistance, information and referral services
